Dates of Creation - 18 December 1605

Scope and Content

Dame Juliana Hesketh, Cuthbert Hesketh, and Thomas Hesketh.

Agreement that a recovery shall be effected of the mills, to provide an endowment for the hospital at Heslington, to use of Juliana for her life, and thereafter to use of Sir Cuthbert Pepper, kt., Richard Hutton, serjeant at law, Robert Dewhurst, and Henry Southworth; close at Heslington called Barton Croft, now in the possession of [] Burton to be conveyed by same recovery to same uses, to provide site for the hospital. The trustees are to lease the mills for periods of 21 years to Cuthbert Hesketh, then Thomas Hesketh and the heirs male of his body, failing whom the leases are to be granted to the owners of the capital messuage of Heslington for an annual rent of £50.

Agreement also contains references to a codicil of a will [Sir Thomas Hesketh's], and legacies to Thomas Hesketh, Andrew Singleton, and Richard Borrowalls, to be arranged so that Thomas Hesketh shall have £30 p.a. Juliana Hesketh is to have half of the residue of the estate before any legacies are paid.
