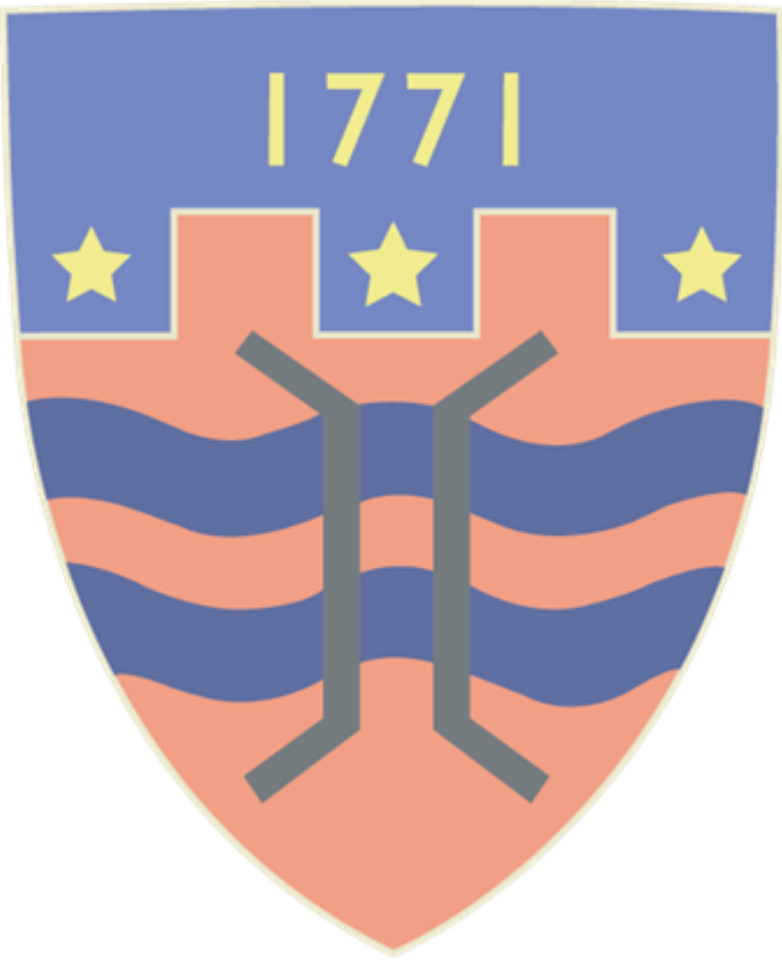


'CEDAR ATLANTICA GLAUCA'


